## SECTION D DETAILS OF SCHOOL

### D1: Type of school

The school is a Gaeltacht Community school which functions according to the mission statement. The Trustees are The Presentation Sisters, The Christian Brothers and Kerry Educational Services. It is a co-educational school. The school is funded by the Department of Education and Science and there are no fees.

### D2: Management

The Board of Management is in charge of the school. The members are nominated by the Trustees, Parents and Teachers (see Appendix 2).

### D3: Organisation

The parent's council and the student's council support the work of the school (see Appendix 3 & 4).

### D4: Resources and Curriculum

The school curriculum is in keeping with the rules of the Department of Education and Science and with section 29 and 30 of the Education Act 1998 which allows changes. The following programmes are available in the school, Junior Certificate, Leaving Certificate Vocational Programme, Transition Year, Leaving Certificate Applied. Learning support programmes are available for students with special educational needs.

### D5: Extra Curriculum Activities

There is a wide range of extra curricular activities available in the school sport / games, debating, quizzes, school tours etc. The purpose of these activities is to preserve and develop the social and personal skills of the students.

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# ENROLMENT POLICY

## SECTION B

### B1: Application Procedure

- An application form must be completed (forms are available from school secretary)
- The student must be twelve years of age on the 1<sup>st</sup> of January of the year she / he begins first year
- A representative of the school will visit each primary school in the school catchment area every year. Application forms and information on the school will be distributed to the prospective students
- Parents / Guardians will be invited to an open night. This will give parents an opportunity to see the school, meet some of the staff and get any questions that they may have answered. All necessary information e.g. mission statement, school organisation code of discipline will be given to the parents on that occasion
- All newly registered students will be assessed. This is done in order to help the school assess the individual needs of every student

To help the needs of the student in Irish she / he will have an interview in Irish in order to assess his / her ability in spoken Irish and accordingly to provide help if necessary e.g. language assistant or homework club. Parents will be asked to verify in writing that they accept the code of discipline, and the language policy of the school and that they will make every reasonable effort to ensure that their son / daughter adheres to the policies. The Board of Management of the school reserve the right to change or amend the above at any time.

### B2: Necessary Information from Parents

- Name, sex, address, date of birth, PPS no of student
- Name(s) address, telephone and mobile numbers of parent(s) guardian(s)
- Emergency phone number. Name of family doctor
- Medical problems
- Information on special needs or disabilities and copies of any available assessments
- Name(s) of previous school(s)
- Reason for transferring (if applicable)
- Religion
- Information on family members attending school
- Any other relevant information

### B3: Decision-Making Process

In keeping with the school policy it is the Board of Management of the school who make the decisions regarding acceptance of students. The Board of Management will make all decisions regarding student registration based on the school policy, Education Act 1998, Education Welfare Act 2000, Equality Act 2000 and Epsen Act 2005. The board will notify the parents within 21 days from receiving the appropriate information. As laid out by the Board, the Minister for Education and in accordance with Education Welfare Act 2000.

### B4: Special Needs

- Every effort will be made to identify students who have special needs as soon as possible and to all information on their particular special needs
- A copy of health / psychological report will be looked for, if available
- An independent professional assessment will be asked for
- Every effort will be made to identify and help those with special needs when the above steps have been followed, in keeping with the professional recommendations of the NEPS psychologist

### B5: Criteria

The board of management of the school will use the following criteria if there are more applications than available places in the school.

- 1 Students attending primary schools in the catchment area (see Appendix 1)
- 2 The earliest applicants
- 3 Students who come to live in the school area

### B6: Students transferring from other schools.

The following factors will be taken into account before any application is accepted.

- School's enrolment policy
- Information will be looked for from previous school e.g. attendance, educational progress, subjects chosen,
